

Leg Grows 2 Inches

A night earlier at pastor Alda's church, I noticed a man walking with a limp. His right shoe had a three-inch platform on it so obviously that leg was shorter than the left. When ministry time began, I grabbed a translator and found him. I asked if I could pray for his leg to grow and he said yes. Within five minutes of praying, a look of pain came over his face. I asked through the translator what was happening. He said, "It hurts!" I asked if it was a bad hurt. He said, "No, it's growing!" It grew over the whole time of ministry about an inch to an inch and a half. I was discouraged when we left because it was not completely healed.

The next night, Friday 07/08/05, he was there again, limping in the shoes. He came to me for more prayer. We dug to the root of the problem. I found out that when he was 8 months old, a wooden bench had fallen on his right side of the hip and the upper part of his right leg. After surgery, he was left with no cartilage between his femur and the socket in his hip. As he grew, the grinding of the bone left that leg shorter than the other. He was lying on the floor with both legs straight out. Knowing the root of the problem, I commanded the cartilage to grow. His right leg bent suddenly at a 90-degree angle. He said, "I couldn't do that before!" Anytime he would sit or stand it would cause pain because the bones would grind and he couldn't bend it much at all. Now there was no pain and he had full flexibility. Then I commanded the femur to grow and extend. His face showed pain and he said, "It feels like God is in there with a tow truck stretching it out." It got within a couple of centimeters and he asked that I stop praying. He got up and walked with no pain and without his lifted shoe. I am still disappointed it wasn't even with his left leg but he said that he believed it would continue to grow through out the night. Whether it does or not, God gave him new cartilage, took the pain, and made his leg grow about 2 inches!
